The History Program requires the following:

- Official undergraduate and graduate transcripts
- Two official letters of reference
- 24 credits in history with a minimum "B" average

Mathematics • M.A.T.

The Mathematics Program requires the following:

- Application/ Personal Statement/Fee
- Official undergraduate and graduate transcripts
- Two official letters of reference
- 24 credits in mathematics beyond pre-calculus or 18 credits in mathematics beyond pre-calculus, plus 6 credits in education with a minimum "B" average

Theology • M.A. / M.T.S.

The Theology Program requires the following:

- Application/ Personal Statement/Fee
- Official undergraduate and graduate transcripts
- Two official letters of reference
- Graduate Record Examination Scores (M.A. only)
- 18 credits in Theology with a minimum "B" average
